### About the Speaker:

The **Honourable Justice John Chaney** was sworn in as a judge of the Supreme Court of Western Australia on 10 February, 2009. His Honour was also appointed as the President of the SAT. Justice Chaney was admitted to practice in 1976. He was appointed Senior Counsel in 2002 and became a judge of the District Court in April 2004. Justice Chaney was appointed Deputy President of the SAT when the tribunal was created on 1 January 2005 and served in that role until his appointment as President.

Justice Chaney was president of the Law Society of Western Australia in 1991 and is a Foundation Director of the Australian Advocacy Institute Ltd. He served as a Commissioner of the District Court on three occasions between 1995 and 2001.
